## **Ordinance Administrative Comment**

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY, THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE PARISH PRESIDENT, TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE ENDEAVOR AGREEMENT WITH THE LOUISIANA COMMUNITY & TECHNICAL COLLEGE SYSTEM ON BEHALF OF NORTHSHORE TECHNICAL COMMUNITY COLLEGE FOR THE DONATION OF 12.6 +/- ACRES OF PROPERTY AT THE ST. TAMMANY ADVANCED CAMPUS SITE (WARD 7, DISTRICT 11)

The Parish seeks to enter into a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement and Act of Donation for the benefit of the Louisiana Community & Technical College System on behalf of Northshore Technical Community College. The property consists of 12.6 +/- acres within Parish's STAC site on Highway 434. NTCC will be required to obtain a survey prior to executing the Act of Donation. The Act of Donation is onerous and shall include restrictive covenants (1) for post-secondary technical training and education purposes and (2) construction timelines, with a right of reversion in favor of Parish in event of breach of either restrictive covenant.

Authority to enter into this CEA and donation includes the Local Services Law (La. R.S. 33:1321, et seq.), La. Const Art. 7 §14(C), and *Board of Directors of Indus. Development Bd. of City of Gonzales, Louisiana, Inc. v. All Taxpayers, Property Owners, Citizens of City of Gonzales, et al*, 938 So.2d 11 (La. 9/6/06).
