RESOLUTION TO A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULT OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD IN ROAD LIGHTING DISTRICT NO. 10 OF THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY, STATE OF LOUISIANA (THE DISTRICT) ON NOVEMBER 4, 2014, FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL OF THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF AN ANNUAL SERVICE CHARGE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$ 50.00 PER STRUCTURE OR LOT FOR A PERIOD OF TEN (10) YEARS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING UTILITY CHARGES FOR ROAD LIGHTING AND MAINTAINING AND OPERATING ROAD LIGHTING FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT WITHIN THE DISTRICT; AND FURTHER PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Parish Council of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of the District, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Governing Authority does now proceed in open and public session to examine the official certified tabulations of votes cast at the special election held in the District on November 4, 2014 (the "Election"), said tabulations having been prepared and certified by the election officials serving at the designated polling places, and the Governing Authority does now further proceed to examine and canvass the returns and declare the result of the Election.

SECTION 2. That a Proces Verbal of the canvass of the returns of the Election shall be made and that a certified copy thereof shall be forwarded to the Secretary of State, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, who shall record the same in his office; that another certified copy thereof shall be forwarded to the Clerk of Court and ex-officio Recorder of Mortgages in and for the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, who shall record the same in the Mortgage Records of St. Tammany Parish; and that another copy thereof shall be retained in the archives of the District.

SECTION 3. That the result of the Election shall be promulgated by publication in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

PROCES VERBAL OF THE CANVASS OF THE VOTES CAST AT THE ELECTION HELD IN ROAD LIGHTING DISTRICT NO. 10 OF THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY, STATE OF LOUISIANA, ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2014.

BE IT KNOWN AND REMEMBERED that on the 2nd day of April, 2015 at 6:00 p.m., at the St. Tammany Government Complex, 21490 Koop Drive, Mandeville, Louisiana, the Parish Council of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of Road Lighting District No. 10 of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "District"), and being the authority ordering the election held therein on Tuesday, November 4, 2014, did examine and canvass the returns of the election, there having been submitted at the election the following proposition, to-wit:

Shall Road Lighting District No. 10 of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "District"), through its governing authority, be authorized to renew and assess an annual service charge of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per structure or lot (an estimated \$1,550.00 is reasonably anticipated to be collected for an entire year) for a period of ten (10) years, beginning with the year 2015 and ending with the year 2024, to persons occupying residential and non-residential structures and persons owning unoccupied structures located wholly or partly within the boundaries of the District and to persons owning lots located wholly or partly within the District upon which no structure is located for the purpose of paying utility charges for road lighting and maintaining and operating road lighting facilities and equipment within the District?

The polling places above specified being the only polling places designated at which to hold the election, it was therefore shown that there was a total of 18 votes cast IN FAVOR OF the Proposition and a total of 12 votes cast AGAINST the Proposition, as hereinabove set forth, and that there was a majority of 18 votes cast IN FAVOR OF the Proposition as hereinabove set forth.

The foregoing election was authorized by a resolution adopted on June 5, 2014 by the Governing Authority and notice therefore was duly given by the Notice of Special Election attached hereto as <u>Exhibit</u> <u>A</u>. Said Notice of Special Election was published on September 4, 2014, September 11, 2014, September 18, 2014 and September 25, 2014 in the *St. Tammany Farmer*, as set forth in the proof of publication attached hereto as <u>Exhibit B</u>.

THEREFORE, the Parish Council of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of Road Lighting District No. 10 of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "District"), does hereby declare and proclaim in open and public session that the Proposition, as hereinabove set forth, was duly PASSED in the District on Tuesday, November 4, 2014, and that the result of said election be promulgated by the Secretary of State and by the Clerk of Court in the manner required by law.
