## ON THE 3 DAY OF JANUARY, 2013

> AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE MORATORIUM ON MUE (6) CONSTRUCTION OR PLACEMENT OF BUILDING STRUCTURES ON PROPERTY WITHIN A PORTION OF VOTING PRECINCT 914. (WARD 8, DISTRICT 14)

WHEREAS, the Parish Council adopted Ordinance C.S. No. 12-2800 imposing a six (6) month moratorium on the issuance of permits for construction or placement of building structures on property within a portion of voting precinct 914 in Council District 14; and

WHEREAS, to protect and preserve the health, safety and property interests of residents within a portion of voting Precinct 914, District 14 of St. Tammany Parish, it is necessary to extend the moratorium to allow sufficient time for evaluation of present drainage conditions and remedies affecting the area more fully described within this ordinance.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS: that it extends the six (6) month moratorium on the issuance of permits for construction or placement of building structures on property within a portion of voting precinct 914 in Council District 14, described as follows:

Commence at the intersection of Hwy. 11 and Haas Road; also the point of beginning, thence follow Haas Road east to its intersection with Hwy. 1091 (Robert Road); thence follow Hwy. 1091 (Robert Road) northwest, north, and northwest to its intersection with the Illinois Central Railroad; thence follow the Illinois Central Railroad northeast to its intersection with Watts Road; thence follow Watts Road northwest to its intersection with Gum Bayou; thence follow Gum Bayou south, southwest, and southeast to its intersection with Son Moore Road; thence follow Son Moore Road west, southeast, and east to its intersection with Gum Bayou; thence follow Gum Bayou southwest and southeast to its intersection with Hwy. 11; thence follow Hwy. 11 southwest to its intersection with Haas Road, also the point of beginning.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon final adoption and remain in effect through August 2, 2013.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the moratorium imposed may be vacated, in whole or in part, by Resolution of this governing body pursuant to Chapter 5, Article II, Section 5-0556.00 of the Parish Code of Ordinances.

REPEAL: All ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption and remain in effect through August 2, 2013.
