ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A NO OVERNIGHT PARKING ZONE ON A PORTION OF LAURENT ROAD (WARD 9, DISTRICT 11)

WHEREAS, the overnight parking of vehicles along a portion of Laurent Rd (R09H007) between Nunez Rd and Coin Du Lestin Dr presents a safety hazard for vehicular traffic.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS: that

SECTION I: A "No Overnight Parking" zone is hereby established on a portion of Laurent Rd (R09H007) between Nunez Rd and Coin Du Lestin Dr.

SECTION II: The Parish Department of Public Works is directed to post the appropriate signs at this location.

REPEAL: All ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after adoption.
