THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS: That the St. tammany Parish Selective Road and Drainage Maintenance System Inventory is amended as follows:

1. Add St. James St (R07G145), approximately 300 feet, located east from S. 12th St. (R07G003), Ward 7, District 7

REPEAL: All ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.
