ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SPEED LIMIT OF 25 MPH ON
THE ROADS WITHIN OAK MANOR ESTATES SUBDIVISION.
(WARD 9, DISTRICT 11)

WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish Government is charged with protecting the safety and general welfare of citizens of the parish; and

WHEREAS, the St. Tammany Parish department of Engineering has evaluated the current speed limit on the roads within Oak Manor Estates subdivision and have determined that the existing speed limit of 20 MPH should be increased to 25 MPH.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION I: A speed limit of 25 MPH is hereby established on the entirety of the following roads within the Oak Manor Estates Subdivision. Ward 9, District 11:

Pleasant Dr. (9-C-10)

Oak Manor Dr. (9-C-22)

Post Oak Dr. (9-C-20)

Pin Oak Dr. (9-C-21)

SECTION II: The Parish Department of Public Works is directed to replace all existing 20 MPH signs on these roads with 25 MPH signs.

SECTION III: If any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any other provision herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

SECTION IV: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION V: This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption.

REPEAL: All ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after adoption.
