

ADMINISTRATIVE COMMENTS

(REV12-11-005 - Revocation of a Portion of Emerald Forest Boulevard)

The applicant owns property to the north of the proposed strip of land to be revoked whom plans on developing a residential single family planned unit development. The applicant wants to incorporate said strip of land into the development for recreation/green space purposes.

Recommendation:

The strip of land in question is owned by St. Tammany Parish; and currently, based upon review of all relevant parish departments, has no intended use by the parish. Therefore, the staff believes that the proposal is consistent relative to the Louisiana Revised Statutes governing the revocation of immovable property since the right-of-way does not appear to serve any public use or benefit, other than to the applicant. Therefore, the staff has no objections to the proposed revocation request.
