

Warranty Obligation (\$16,000)

Honorable Council Members:

The Warranty Obligation in the amount of \$16,000 expires April 29, 2015 and is scheduled for review by the Parish Council at the March 5, 2015 meeting.

The developer was notified on January 12, 2015 by the Department of Engineering of the punch list items required and for his engineer to certify to this office at least (60) sixty days prior to the expiration of the obligation, that the punch list has been completed.

This office has not received such notification. Therefore, this obligation must be extended for one (1) year or until the work is satisfactorily accomplished.

The punch list items are as follows:

As-Built Drawing

- 1. As-Built information is needed for the detention pond since it will be maintained by St. Tammany Parish.
- 2. Typical X-section of detention pond is needed on the As-Built drawing.
- 3. The outfall culvert from POND #2 to the pond in Phase 1 is <u>BCCMP</u> not <u>RCP</u> as shown on the drawing; please revise.

General

- There is a functioning AUDUBON (fountain) within the detention pond. Since this pond will be dedicated to STP for maintenance, it will be necessary that you contact the Parish Legal Department for necessary approvals to maintain the Audubon before we can recommend that the pond be accepted for maintenance.
- 2. All bare areas of the detention pond access surface and slopes must have a mature stand of grass to prevent erosion.

Signage

1. The existing street name sign blades do not conform with the current Parish standards.

The traffic signage ordinance is currently being reviewed for submission to the Planning
Commission and the Parish Council for approval. Therefore, a decision will be made at
that time regarding the acceptability of the street name sign blades.

The posts have already been approved as being crashworthy.
