WHEREAS, on October 16, 2014 the St. Tammany Parish Council adopted Ordinance No. 5238 establishing the St. Tammany Geographic Information System District; and

WHEREAS, the the mayors of municipalities and the chiefs of fire districts has chosen a nominee to submit to the St. Tammany Parish Council to appoint; and

WHEREAS, the St. Tammany Parish Council now wishes to recognize and appoint said nominees.
