RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT AND AUTHORIZE THE PARISH PRESIDENT’S FORMAL REQUEST TO THE LOUISIANA OFFICE OF STATE PARKS’ RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE TAMMANY TRACE.

WHEREAS, the Recreational Trails Program is a state-administered, federal aid grant program funded by the National Recreational Trails Fund Act of 1991 and extended by MAP 21 of 2012 for the purpose of providing and maintaining recreational trails and trails-related facilities; and

WHEREAS, regulations require an application to have a resolution of support from the local governmental body of the jurisdiction in which the proposed project is located; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project will provide improvements to create a smooth transition into the City of Slidell from the culmination of the Tammany Trace at the end of Garden Drive to West Hall Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the project will be in partnership with the City of Slidell who will eventually extend the Trace to Heritage Park.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY RESOLVES to support the application being submitted to the Louisiana Recreational Trails Program and authorizes the Parish President to sign and submit any and all necessary applications, requests and award documents for this purpose.
