- 2. Install NO THRU TRUCKS sign on Marigold, 50' from the Marigold and Hwy 21 intersection.
- 3. Install NO THRU TRUCKS sign on N. Azalea, 50' from the Azalea and Hwy 21 intersection.






Figure 2A-2. Examples of Heights and Lateral Locations of Sign Installations
