RESOLUTION APPROVING THE HOLDING OF AN ELECTION IN FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 1 OF THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY, STATE OF LOUISIANA, ON SATURDAY, MARCH 28, 2015, TO AUTHORIZE THE RENEWAL OF A PARCEL FEE THEREIN.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Fire Protection District No. 1 of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of Fire Protection District No. 1 of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "District"), plans to call a special election in the District on Saturday, March 28, 2015, to authorize the renewal of a parcel fee therein; and

WHEREAS, the governing authority of the District has requested that this Parish Council, acting as the governing authority of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, give its consent and authority for the District to hold the aforesaid election, and in the event that the election carries to levy and collect the parcel fee provided for therein; and

WHEREAS, as required by Article VI, Section 15 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, it is now the desire of this Parish Council to approve the holding of said election and in the event that the election carries, to further approve the levy and collection of the parcel fee provided for therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Parish Council of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, acting as the governing authority of said Parish, that:

SECTION 1. In compliance with the provisions of Article VI, Section 15 of the constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, and in accordance with the request of the Board of Commissioners of Fire Protection District No. 1 of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, this Parish Council hereby approves the holding of an election in the District, on Saturday, March 28, 2015, at which election there will be submitted the following proposition, to-wit:

PROPOSITION (PARCEL FEE RENEWAL)

Shall Fire Protection District No. 1 of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, (the "District"), continue to levy and collect an annual parcel fee of Thirty-Nine Dollars (\$ 39.00) on each lot, subdivided portion of ground or individual tract upon which is located, either in whole or in part, a residential or commercial structure, regardless of the structure's being occupied or unoccupied (an estimated \$ 1,189,263 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the service charge for an entire year), for a period of ten (10) years, beginning with the year 2016 and ending with the year 2025, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, maintaining and operating fire protection facilities and equipment, including obtaining water for fire protection purposes and paying personnel costs, and all purposes incidental thereto?

SECTION 2. In the event the election carries, this Parish Council does hereby further consent to and authorize the District to levy and collect the parcel fee provided for therein.

The following resolution was offered by Troy Brackett and seconded by Kevin Kingston:

### RESOLUTION

A resolution ordering and calling a special election to be held in Fire Protection District No. 1 of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, to authorize the renewal of a parcel fee therein; making application to the State Bond Commission in connection therewith; and providing for other matters in connection therewith.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Fire Protection District No. 1 of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of Fire Protection District No. 1 of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "District"), that:

SECTION 1. <u>Election Call</u>. Subject to the approval of the State Bond Commission and the St. Tammany Parish Council, and under the authority conferred by Article VI, Sections 30 and 32 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, Section 1505 of Title 40 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended, the applicable provisions of Chapter 5 and Chapter 6-A of the Louisiana Election Code, and other constitutional and statutory authority, a special election is hereby called and ordered to be held in the District on **SATURDAY**, **MARCH 28**, 2015, between the hours of seven o'clock (7:00) a.m. and eight o'clock (8:00) p.m., in accordance with the provisions of La. R.S. 18:541, and at the said election there shall be submitted to all registered voters qualified and entitled to vote at the said election under the Constitution and laws of this State and the Constitution of the United States, the following proposition, to-wit:

## PROPOSITION (PARCEL FEE RENEWAL)

Shall Fire Protection District No. 1 of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, (the "District"), continue to levy and collect an annual parcel fee of Thirty-Nine Dollars (\$39.00) on each lot, subdivided portion of ground or individual tract upon which is located, either in whole or in part, a residential or commercial structure, regardless of the structure's being occupied or unoccupied (an estimated \$1,189,263 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the service charge for an entire year), for a period of ten (10) years, beginning with the year 2016 and ending with the year 2025, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, maintaining and operating fire protection facilities and equipment, including obtaining water for fire protection purposes and paying personnel costs, and all purposes incidental thereto?

SECTION 2. <u>Publication of Notice of Election</u>. A Notice of Special Election shall be published in the *St. Tammany Farmer*, a newspaper of general circulation within the District, published in Covington, Louisiana, and being the official journal of the District, once a week for four consecutive weeks, with the first publication to be made not less than forty-five (45) days nor more than ninety (90) days prior to the date of the election, which Notice shall be substantially in the form attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and incorporated herein by reference the same as if it were set forth herein in full.

SECTION 3. <u>Canvass</u>. This Governing Authority shall meet at its regular meeting place, the Towers Building, 520 Old Spanish Trail, Slidell, Louisiana, on **TUESDAY**, **APRIL 21, 2015**, at **SIX O'CLOCK** (6:00) **P.M.**, and shall then and there in open and public session proceed to examine and canvass the returns and declare the result of the said special election.

SECTION 4. <u>Polling Places</u>. The polling places set forth in the aforesaid Notice of Special Election are hereby designated as the polling places at which to hold the said election, and the Commissioners-in-Charge and Commissioners, respectively, will be the same persons as those designated in accordance with law.

SECTION 5. <u>Election Commissioners; Voting Machines</u>. The officers designated to serve as Commissioners-in-Charge and Commissioners pursuant to Section 4 hereof, or such substitutes therefor as may be selected and designated in accordance with La. R.S. 18:1287, shall hold the said special election as herein provided, and shall make due returns of said election for the meeting of the Governing Authority to be held on Tuesday, April 21, 2015, as provided in Section 3 hereof. All registered voters in the District will be entitled to vote at the special election, and voting machines shall be used.

SECTION 6. <u>Authorization of Officers</u>. The Secretary of the Governing Authority is hereby empowered, authorized and directed to arrange for and to furnish to said election officers in ample time for the holding of said election, the necessary equipment, forms and other paraphernalia essential to the proper holding of said election and the Chairman and/or Secretary of the Governing Authority are further authorized, empowered and directed to take any and all further action required by State and/or Federal law to arrange for the election.

SECTION 7. <u>Furnishing Election Call to Election Officials</u>. Certified copies of this resolution shall be forwarded to the Secretary of State, the Clerk of Court and *Ex-Officio* Parish Custodian of Voting Machines of St. Tammany Parish and the Registrar of Voters of St. Tammany Parish, as notification of the special election, in order that each may prepare for said election and perform their respective functions as required by law.

SECTION 8. <u>Application to State Bond Commission</u>. Application is made to the State Bond Commission for consent and authority to hold the special election as herein provided, and in the event said election carries for further consent and authority to continue to levy and collect the parcel fee provided for therein. A certified copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to the State Bond Commission on behalf of this Governing Authority, together with a letter requesting the prompt consideration and approval of this application.

SECTION 9. <u>Approval of Governing Authority of the Parish</u>. Application is hereby made to the Parish Council of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, for consent and authority to hold the special election as herein provided, and in the event the election carries, for its further consent and authority to continue to levy and collect the parcel fee provided for therein. A certified copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to the Parish Council of the Parish of St. Tammany on behalf of the District, together with a letter requesting the prompt consideration and approval of this application.
