AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A NO PARKING ZONE ON A PORTION OF CHERRY STREET. WARD 9, DISTRICT 11

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS, that

SECTION I: A "NO PARKING ZONE" is hereby established on a portion of Cherry Street (R09D001), specifically on east side of the street, 15 feet in each direction directly across from driveway located @ 1545 Cherry Street. Ward 9, District 11.

SECTION II: The Parish Department of Public Works is directed to post the appropriate signs (No Parking Between Signs) at this location.

SECTION III: If any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any other provision herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

SECTION IV: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION V: This ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after adoption.
