AN ORDINANCE TO CORRECT THE ROAD INVENTORY TO INCLUDE AN EXTENSION OF DUPARD STREET, LOCATED OFF OF SOULT . WARD 4, DISTRICT 10

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS, that

SECTION I: The St. Tammany Parish Selective Road Maintenance System Inventory is amended to include an extension of Dupard Street (approximately 266 feet on the west end), located off of Soult Street (R04E036). Ward 4, District 10.

SECTION II: The Department of Public Works is directed to obtain, place, and/or remove the appropriate streets signs as necessary to effectuate said amendment.

SECTION III: If any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any other provision herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

SECTION IV: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION V: This ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after adoption.
