ORDINANCE TO AMEND PARISH CODE OF ORDINANCES, APPENDIX B, SUBDIVISION REGULATORY ORDINANCE NO. 499, SECTION 40-061.0 ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS TO PRELIMINARY SUBDIVISION REVIEW TO PROVIDE FOR BACK SLOPE REQUIREMENTS OF ROADSIDE DITCHES.

WHEREAS, to further the interests of public safety and to provide for improvements in drainage and flood control, it is necessary to establish additional requirements in roadside ditch design and construction standards.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS to amend the Code of Ordinances, Appendix B, Subdivision Regulatory Ordinance No. 499, Section 40-061.0, to provide for back slope requirements of roadside ditches as an additional requirement to preliminary subdivision review as follows, to wit:

SECTION 40-061.0 ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS TO PRELIMINARY
SUBDIVISION REVIEW

2. Design and construction of all drainage shall be in accordance with specifications and standards of the State of Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development (DOTD). The design engineer shall certify that all drainage plans shall include open ditch and subsurface designs. Driveway culverts shall be designed in accordance with the subsurface design. Design information shall be submitted to the Department of Public Works. In addition to meeting current DOTD specifications and standards, the following requirements for drainage design and construction shall be met:
 - a. All roadside open ditch design and construction shall reflect a 3:1 back slope to depth ratio.
 - a. b. All subsurface drainage installation within Police Jury Parish Council District 13 shall be required to meet the standards as set forth in Section 40-037.01 of this ordinance. (amended by Ord. No. 96-2511, adopted 10/17/96)

REPEAL: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this Ordinances are hereby declared to be severable.

DATE OF ENACTMENT: This Ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after adoption.
