RESOLUTION

A resolution providing for canvassing the returns and declaring the result of the special election held in Sales Tax District No. Three of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, on Saturday, July 16, 2005, to authorize the levy of a sales and use tax therein.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Parish Council of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of Sales Tax District No. Three of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "District"), that:

SECTION 1. <u>Canvass</u>. This Governing Authority does now proceed in open and public session to examine the official tabulations of votes cast at the special election held in Sales Tax District No. Three of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, (the "District"), on SATURDAY, JULY 16, 2005, to authorize the levy of a sales and use tax therein, and said Governing Authority does further proceed to examine and canvass the returns and declare the result of the special election.

SECTION 2. <u>Procès Verbal</u>. A *Procès Verbal* of the canvass of the returns of said election shall be made and a certified copy thereof shall be forwarded to the Secretary of State, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, who shall record the same in his office; another certified copy thereof shall be forwarded to the Clerk of Court and *Ex-Officio* Recorder of Mortgages in and for the Parish of St. Tammany, who shall record the same in the Mortgage Records of said Parish; and another copy thereof shall be retained in the archives of this Governing Authority.

SECTION 3. <u>Promulgation of Election Result.</u> The result of said election shall be promulgated by publication in the manner provided by law.

BE IT KNOWN AND REMEMBERED that on Thursday, August 4, 2005, at six o'clock (6:00) p.m., at its regular meeting place, the Council Chambers of the Parish Government Complex, 21490 Koop Drive, Mandeville, Louisiana, the Parish Council of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of Sales Tax District No. Three of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "District"), and being the authority ordering the special election held therein on Saturday, July 16, 2005, with the following members present:

There being absent:

did, in open and public session, examine the official certified tabulations of votes cast at the said election, and did examine and canvass the returns of the said election, there having been submitted at said election the following proposition, to wit:

SALES TAX DISTRICT NO. THREE PROPOSITION (SALES TAX CONTINUATION & REDEDICATION)

SUMMARY: 2% SALES TAX CONTINUATION FOR 25 YEARS FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING, ACQUIRING, EXTENDING, IMPROVING, MAINTAINING AND/OR OPERATING (i) ROADS, STREETS AND BRIDGES AND (ii) DRAINS AND DRAINAGE FACILITIES, INCLUDING ACQUIRING ALL NECESSARY LAND, EQUIPMENT AND FURNISHINGS FOR ANY OF SAID PUBLIC WORKS, IMPROVEMENTS AND FACILITIES, AND FURTHER INCLUDING ALLOCATIONS TO MUNICIPALITIES UNDER INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENTS RELATING TO ANNEXATIONS, REVENUE SHARING AREAS AND GROWTH MANAGEMENT AREAS.

Shall Sales Tax District No. Three of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "District"), under the provisions of Article VI, Section 29 of the Louisiana Constitution of 1974, and other constitutional and statutory authority, be authorized to continue to levy and collect the tax of two per cent (2%) (the "Tax"), previously authorized at an election held on November 4, 1986, for an additional period of 25 years commencing December 1, 2006, upon the sale at retail, the use, the lease or rental, the consumption and the storage for use or consumption, of tangible personal property and on sales of services in the District, with the net proceeds of the Tax heretofore or hereafter collected (after paying the reasonable and necessary costs and expenses of collecting and administering the Tax), to be rededicated and used for the purposes of constructing, acquiring, extending, improving, maintaining and/or operating (i) roads, streets and bridges and (ii) drains and drainage facilities, including acquiring all necessary land, equipment and furnishings for any of said public works, improvements and facilities, and further including allocation of funds under intergovernmental agreements with municipalities relating to annexations, revenue sharing areas and growth management areas, to be used by said municipalities for any one or more of the aforesaid purposes that have a benefit to residents of the District, and shall the District be further authorized to fund the proceeds of the Tax into bonds from time to time for any of said capital improvements, to the extent and in the manner permitted by the laws of Louisiana, including Sub-Part F, Part III, Chapter 4, Title 39 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950?
