AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A "NO THRU TRUCKS" ZONE ON JACKSON STREET, BETWEEN HIGHWAY 21 AND PLANTATION STREET. WARD 3, DISTRICT 3

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS, that

SECTION I: A "NO THRU TRUCKS" ZONE is hereby established on Jackson Street (R03J010) between LA. Highway 21 and Plantation Street, as indicated on the attached traffic plan by the Department of Engineering. WARD 3, DISTRICT 3.

SECTION II: The Parish Department of Public Works is directed to post the appropriate signs at these locations.

SECTION III: If any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any other provision herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

SECTION IV: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV: This ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after adoption.

ADMINISTRATIVE COMMENT

Reference No.: 3261

Administrative Department: Public Works
