A RESOLUTION PERMITTING THE PARISH PRESIDENT TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF MANDEVILLE FOR THE SHARING OF COSTS RELATED TO HIGHWAY 22 EAST DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS, PHASE II.B OF LA HIGHWAY 22 AND BAYOU TETE L'OURS AREA DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, control and disposition of excess surface water has become a matter of critical importance in the southern reaches of Beau Chene Subdivision, among the commercial sites that line the southern side of LA Highway 22, and in and around Woodridge Subdivision to the west and the Fire Station and Hibernia Bank to the east on LA Highway 22.

WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish Government ("STPG") has secured grant funding from the Division of Administration - Facility Planning and Control for LA Highway 22 and Bayou Tete L'Ours Area Drainage Improvements ("the project").

WHEREAS, STPG's estimates of construction costs exceed the grant funding available for all phases of the project; and the City of Mandeville has agreed to share the Phase II.B costs since that phase is within the city limits of Mandeville.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY permits the Parish President to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Mandeville for the sharing of costs attributable to the Highway 22 East Drainage Improvements.
