WHEREAS, the <u>Town of Madisonville</u> is contemplating annexation of <u>69.9</u> acres of land more or less owned by <u>Woodlands LLC, James Scherer & Jan Songy</u> , and located <u>Sect 38, T7S, R10E</u> , Ward <u>1</u> , District <u>1</u> (see attachments for complete description); and
WHEREAS, the proposed annexation is/is not consistent with the Annexation Agreement entered into by theTown of Madisonville _ and St. Tammany Parish effective April 1, 2003; and
WHEREAS, the property requires rezoning from Parish Residential District which is not an intensification of zoning, and
WHEREAS, the property is not developed and the proposed annexation would not result in a split of the sales tax revenues, all sales tax revenue accrues to the Town of Madisonville.

TAMMANY HEREBY RESOLVES to Concur/Not Concur with the Madisonville annexation and rezoning of 69.9 acres of land more or less, located SECT 38, TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY from Parish R-rural District to Madisonville A - Residential District in accordance with the April 1, 2003 Annexation Agreement between the Parish and the Madisonville.
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should this property be annexed, the St. Tammany Parish Council requires that the <u>Town of Madisonville</u> review development proposals utilizing the applicable Parish Drainage Model and compliance with Parish Drainage Regulations.
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the St. Tammany Parish Council requires that the <u>Town of Madisonville</u> require a Traffic Impact Analysis be performed and that the Parish Department of Engineering be consulted on the traffic and access impacts of any proposed development.

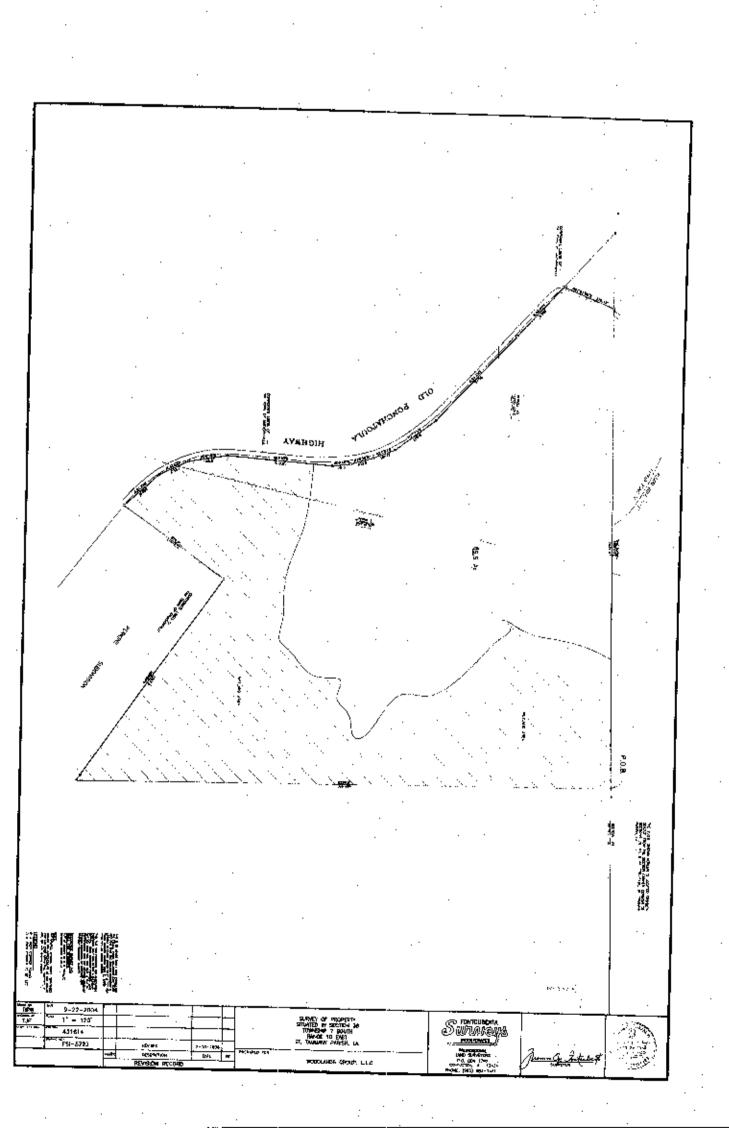

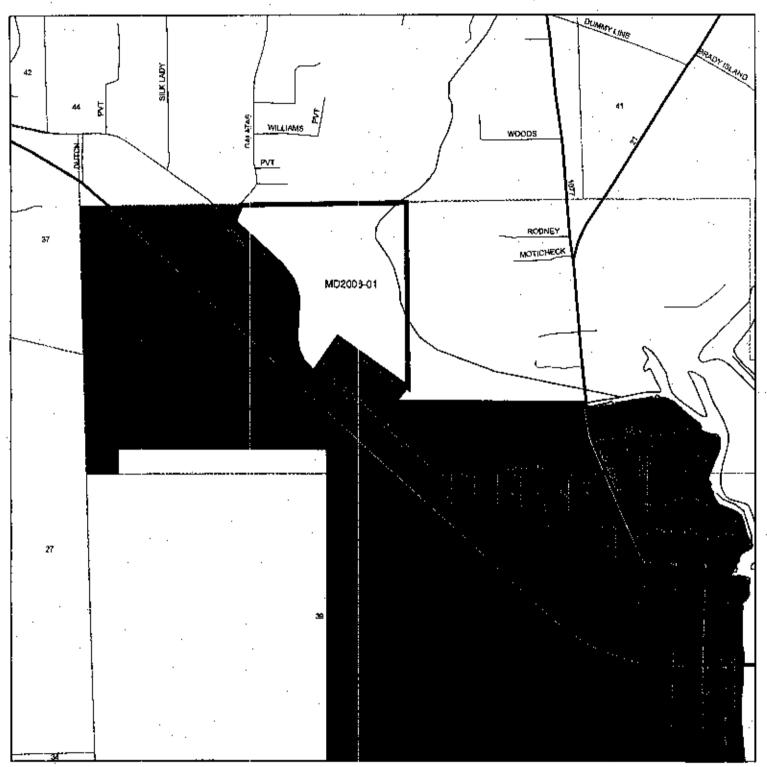
