
1- No Outlet

The Department of Engineering recommends the installation of one "No Outlet" sign & two "No Thru Trucks" to be installed at the entrances of Crestwood Estates. Install the "No Outlet" sign on the top pole and the "No Thru Trucks" sign underneath.

- 1. Remove: Faded "No Outlet" sign located 49' east of Falconer Dr.
- 2. Install: "No Outlet" & "No Thru Trucks", on the same pole, 49' east of Falconer Dr. with the "No Outlet" sign on the top portion of the pole and the "No Thru Trucks" sign underneath.
- 3. Install: "No Thru Trucks" sign underneath the existing "No Outlet" sign located 275' from 9th Ave., on Turnwood Dr.





CHANNELIZED INTERSECTION




MINOR CROSSROAD

MARKED OR UNMARKED CROSSWALK



1- 0.6 m (2 H) MIN.




DIVISIONAL ISLAND
