AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE III, SECTION 3-02 OF THE HOME RULE CHARTER OF THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY, STATE OF LOUISIANA, TO REPEAL THE TERM LIMIT PROVISION FOR THE OFFICE OF PARISH PRESIDENT.

WHEREAS, this Parish Council proposes to call an election to be held on October 20, 2007, for the submission of the following proposition relative to the amendment of the Home Rule Charter of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana:

CHARTER AMENDMENT PROPOSITION (NO TERM LIMIT)

SUMMARY: AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE III, SECTION 3-02 TO REPEAL THE TERM LIMIT PROVISION FOR THE OFFICE OF PARISH PRESIDENT.

Shall Article III, Section 3-02, be amended to repeal the term limit provision for the office of parish president and hereafter provide as follows:

"Section 3-02. Election.

The president shall be elected at large by the qualified voters of the Parish according to the election laws of the state for a four (4) year term. A person who has served as president shall be eligible to qualify as a candidate for president for the succeeding term.

WHEREAS, subject to the approval of the voters at the October 20, 2007 election, this Parish Council now desires to provide for an amendment to said Home Rule Charter.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS by the Parish Council of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "Parish"), that:

SECTION 1. Amendment. Subject to voter approval at an election to be held on October 20, 2007, Article III, Section 3-02 of the Home Rule Charter of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, is hereby amended to repeal the term limit provision for the office of parish president and hereafter provide as follows:

"Section 3-02. Election.

The president shall be elected at large by the qualified voters of the Parish according to the election laws of the state for a four (4) year term. A person who has served as president shall be eligible to qualify as a candidate for president for the succeeding term."

SECTION 2. Repeal. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
