**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY, THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE PARISH PRESIDENT, TO DONATE ONE (1) PERKIN-ELMER/L3 X-RAY SCANNER MACHINE BEARING SERIAL NUMBER 151019, TO WASHINGTON PARISH GOVERNMENT TO BE USED FOR THE PROTECTION OF ITS EMPLOYEES AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC**

WHEREAS, the Parish of St. Tammany no longer has a use for this machine and has deemed it surplus goods; and

WHEREAS, this machine is designed for screening luggage, boxes, briefcases and other small items as a matter of security typically used at government buildings, courtrooms, and other public buildings which is necessary and critical for the safety, health and welfare of the general public in St. Tammany Parish and other neighboring parishes; and

WHEREAS, there is an immediate need and use for one of these machines in order to provide extra security needed at the Washington Parish Courthouse for the protection of employees and the general public.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY RESOLVES, by the St. Tammany Parish Council acting in its capacity as the governing authority, that it declares the above described assets as surplus and does hereby authorize the Office of the Parish President to exercise its discretion, together with all agreements and all transactions, in donating one (1) Perkin-Elmer Model L3 Communications Linescan 210 X-ray Scanner bearing Serial No. 151019 to the Washington Parish Government to be used for the protection of its employees and the general public
