STAFF COMMENTS:

The petitioner is requesting to change the zoning from A-2 (Suburban) District to C-2 (Highway Commercial) District. The site is located on the west side of LA Highway 59, south of Caroline Street, north of America Street. The 2025 future land use plan designates the site to be developed with commercial uses. Considering the close proximity of the site to some single family residences, staff feels that a rezoning to LC (Light Commercial) District would be more appropriate.
