RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE LOUISIANA DEPARTMENT OF WILDLIFE AND FISHERIES AND THE LOUISIANA LEGISLATURE NAME THE BOAT LAUNCH AT U.S. HIGHWAY 90 AND THE PEARL RIVER AS EDWARD C. SCOGIN MEMORIAL BOAT LAUNCH.

WHEREAS, Edward C. Scogin a native and life long resident of Slidell, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, served as a Police Juror from 1968 until he was elected State Representative of House District No. 76 in 1971 and served that District until 1991; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Scogin was an environmentalist who sponsored legislation for the preservation of Louisiana swampland and protection of mineral royalties for parishes surrounding Lake Pontchartrain and Lake Maurepas; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Scogin was instrumental in getting boat launches built throughout the State; and

WHEREAS, the St. Tammany Parish Council wishes to request that the boat launch at Highway 90 and the Pearl River be named the Edward C. Scogin Memorial Boat Launch in memory of a respected public servant and early environmentalist.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY RESOLVES to request that the Secretary of the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries and the St. Tammany Parish Legislative Delegation, receive a copy of this Resolution and urging them to support the naming of the boat launch at Highway 90 and the Pearl River in Slidell, Louisiana, as Edward C. Scogin Memorial Boat Launch.
