TO: ST. TAMMANY PARISH (Grantee)

THIS ACT OF TRANSFER AND ACCEPTANCE IS ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN:

THE MILITARY DEPARTMENT OF THE STATE OF LOUISIANA (Grantor), herein represented by Colonel (Retired) Lester R. Schmidt, Sr., State Contracting Officer, a person of lawful age, whose mailing address is 718 E Street, Camp Beauregard, Pineville, LA 71360-3737, State of Louisiana, being duly authorized and acting on behalf of Major General Bennett C. Landreneau, The Adjutant General of Louisiana, to grant and transfer this Servitude and Right of Way for St. Tammany Parish to construct the Airport Road Extension through Camp Villere, Slidell, Louisiana.

GRANTOR, in consideration of one (\$1.00) dollar, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and full acquittance granted therefore, and such other good and valuable considerations set forth herein, does hereby grant, transfer, set over and assign unto ST. TAMMANY PARISH, a political subdivision of the State of Louisiana, whose address is Post Office Box 628, Covington, Louisiana 70434, herein represented by its Parish President, Kevin Davis, as duly authorized by Council Ordinance C.S. No. \_\_\_\_\_\_, accepting for Grantee and to its successors or assigns, a servitude and right of way upon the property of Grantor, which is situated in the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, and is more particularly described as follows:

A certain portion of ground situated in Section 20, T-8 S – R 14 E, Greenburg Land District, consisting of a 10.681 acre parcel of land located on Camp Villere, St. Tammany Parish, State of Louisiana, and being more particularly described on the Survey, dated August 2006, by All South Consulting Engineers, L.L.C., a copy which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

GRANTOR and GRANTEE acknowledge and agree that the servitude and right of way are for the purpose of placing, constructing, repairing and maintaining a public road, under the Airport Road Extension Project, Project No. 200-01-08, which road is to be constructed on the servitude and right of way herein granted, and to maintain said right of way, including mowing as required.

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GRANTOR and GRANTEE further acknowledge and agree that the following rights are also granted: the right, consistent with law, to allow ingress to and egress from said servitude and public road at all times.

It is understood and agreed that the servitude and right of way hereby granted is typically <u>150</u> feet in width as depicted on the survey provided by All South Consulting Engineers, L.L.C., which is attached hereto. (See Attachment)

GRANTOR and GRANTEE further acknowledge and agree that Grantor retains the right to cross through the servitude and right of way for Grantor's own purpose of accessing its land, on either side of the servitude granted, as long as such use does not interfere with the servitude and rights herein granted. However, Grantor shall not erect, locate or permit the erection or locations of any structure or object of any type whatever within said servitude and right of way, but Grantor shall require, as set forth below, that the Grantee fence any or all of the said property.

GRANTOR and GRANTEE further acknowledge and agree that this servitude and right of way and is granted and accepted subject to the following restrictions: Grantee shall fence the right of way on both sides of the right of way granted hereby. Grantee will install five (5) gates, with appropriate locks, in locations agreed to by both parties hereto, for Grantor's access to its property. Grantee shall provide culverts as required to permit Grantor to gain road access to the road to be constructed by Grantee and to service Grantor's property.

GRANTOR and GRANTEE further acknowledge and agree that this Act of Transfer and Acceptance does not convey any interest or rights whatever in or to any oil, gas or other minerals that are in, on or under the above described land.

GRANTOR and GRANTEE further acknowledge and agree that the servitude and right of way are granted by the Military Department of the State of Louisiana to St. Tammany Parish in perpetuity, unless terminated by the mutual consent of both parties to this agreement.
