WHEREAS, it is no longer the desire of the Parish Government to disallow the use of recycled asphalt on Parish projects;

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY RESOLVES to rescind Resolution Police Jury Series No. 89-4073, adopted May 18, 1989; to provide for revising the existing St. Tammany Parish Bid Specification and General Conditions, Section 02513 - Asphaltic Cement Concrete Pavement, Part 2 - Materials, to remove Item B in its entirety thereby allowing use of recycled asphalt on Parish projects.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Division of Capital Improvements is hereby directed to issue addendum and notice of same.

ASPHALTIC CEMENT CONCRETE PAVEMENTPART 1 General1.1 Description

## A. Work included:

1. Hauling, spreading and compacting the asphaltic cement concrete to the lines, grades, sections and thicknesses shown on the plans.

## B. Work not included:

1. Base repair and drainage.

PART 2 Materials

- A. Asphaltic cement concrete shall conform with all of the requirements of L.D.O.T.D. for the various types shown on the plans.

PART 3 Execution

- A. All work shall be in conformance with the requirements of L.D.O.T.D.
- B. All intersecting roads and streets to be paved a minimum of 20' from the edge of roadway being overlaid.
- C. Minimum turning radius of 35' (where existing conditions allow) at intersecting roads.
- D. All driveways to have a minimum 3' apron sufficient to transition existing driveways to the edge of road being overlaid. Minimum driveway radius is to be 12'.

PART 4 Measurement and Payment

- A. Asphalt shall be measured by the square yard and paid for at the contract unit price per square yard complete in place minus any deduction for deficiencies.
- B. No direct payment shall be made for 20' paving on intersecting roads and driveway transitions.
