AN ORDINANCE TO CORRECT THE ROAD AND DRAINAGE INVENTORY TO INCLUDE LAKESHORE BOULEVARD EAST, OAK HARBOR BOULEVARD EXTENSION; 2 FISH HATCHERY ROAD LATERALS; AND MCKINNEY ROAD LATERAL. WARDS 7, 8 & 9, DISTRICTS 7, 13 & 14

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS, that

SECTION I: The St. Tammany Parish Selective Road and Drainage Maintenance System Inventory is amended as follows:

1. Add Lakeshore Boulevard East, located off Oak Harbor Boulevard Ext., Ward 9, District 13;
2. Add Oak Harbor Boulevard Extension, located off Lakeshore Blvd North, Ward 9, Dist. 13;
3. Add Fish Hatchery Road Lateral Ditch # D07EW14001, located east off Fish Hatchery Road, across from Zelda Drive, Ward 7, District 7;
4. Add Fish Hatchery Road Lateral Ditch # D07EW15001, located south from D07EW11001, Ward 7, District 7; and
5. Add McKinney Road Lateral Ditch #D08KW02002, located south from McKinney Road, Ward 8, District 14

SECTION II: The Department of Public Works is directed to obtain, place, and/or remove the appropriate streets signs as necessary to effectuate said amendments.

SECTION III: If any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any other provision herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

SECTION IV: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION V: This ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after adoption.
