AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A "NO THRU TRUCKS" ZONE ON SLEMMER (3-L-6) ROAD WARD 3, DISTRICT 5.

WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish Government is charged with protecting the safety and general welfare of citizens of the parish; and

WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish has experienced an increase in truck traffic, proceeding at unsafe speeds through the primarily residential neighborhood of Slemmer Road;

WHEREAS, the affected citizens have requested a no thru truck zone to remedy the situation.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS, that

SECTION I: A "NO THRU TRUCKS" ZONE is hereby established on Slemmer Road (3-L-6), as indicated on the attached traffic plan by the Department of Engineering, WARD 3, DISTRICT 5.

SECTION II: The Parish Department of Public Works is directed to post the appropriate signs at these locations.

SECTION III: If any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any other provision herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

SECTION IV: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV: This ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after adoption.

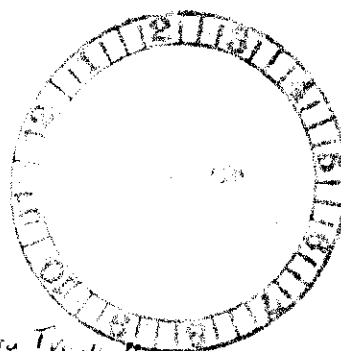

The Department of Engineering recommends the installation of signage in District 5.

1. Install "No Truck Through" sign below existing SL 20 sign located at the intersection of Slemmer and 190 Service.
2. Remove old "Pole" next to JOB #1.
3. Install "No Trucks Through" sign on Slemmer, 40' from the intersection of Slemmer and Helenbirg.
4. Replace "STOP" sign at the intersection of Slemmer and Helenbirg.
5. Remove old "NO Littering" sign on the southeast end of Slemmer.

Please install signs in accordance with MUTCD standards and see the attached sketch.
