ORDINANCE TO EXTEND FOR AN ADDITIONAL SIX (6) MONTH THE MORATORIUM ON THE ISSUANCE OF BUILDING PERMITS FOR CONSTRUCTION OR PLACEMENT OF BUILDING STRUCTURES ON PROPERTY WITHIN PORTIONS OF BEVERLY HILLS AND KINGSPONT SUBDIVISIONS (WARD 8, DISTRICT 14).

WHEREAS, the Parish Council adopted Ordinance C.S. No. 08-1908 extending the six (6) month moratorium on the issuance of permits for construction or placement of building structures on property within portions of Beverly Hills and Kingspoint Subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, the moratorium was created to protect and preserve the health, safety and property interests of residents from worsening conditions resulting from continued building construction activities in the area; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to further extend the moratorium until implementation of proper solutions among regulatory agencies is accomplished and appropriate improvements to infrastructure are made.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS that it extends for an additional six (6) month moratorium on the issuance of building permits for construction or placement of building structures on property within certain portions of Beverly Hills Subdivision and Kingspoint Subdivision, Ward 8, District 14, as more fully described herein:

The properties subject to this moratorium shall be those located within an area whose boundaries begin at the intersection of La. Highway 190 Business (a.k.a Shortcut Highway) and Brookter Road, then commencing West along La. Highway 190 Business to its intersection with the imaginary line forming the section line separating Sections 13 and 14 of Township 9 South, Range 14 East, and then following the section line South to its intersection with Voters Road, then proceeding East along Voters Road to its intersection with Brookter Road, then following Brookter Road to its intersection with La. Highway 190 Business, and to include all properties directly abutting the east side of Brookter Road, and said intersection being the point of beginning; and as further described on the attached map.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon final adoption and shall remain in effect through October 2, 2009.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the moratorium herein imposed may be vacated, in whole or in part, by Resolution of this governing body pursuant to Chapter 5, Article II, Section 5-056.00 of the Parish Code of Ordinances.

REPEAL: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.
