WHEREAS, the Parish instituted a process and schedule for Comprehensive Amendments to Parish Zoning Districts and Regulations. Following adoption of such amendments, the parish will initiate comprehensive rezoning of areas within unincorporated St. Tammany Parish, including Ward 1, District 1; and

WHEREAS, the property located within the triangular shaped area bounded on the South by Highway 190, on the East by the Tchefuncte River, and on the West by the St. Tammany Parish and Tangipahoa Parish line, is expected to be one of the initial areas subject to the Parish's comprehensive study and rezoning; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated pace of continued growth in the moratorium area has a significant potential to adversely impact the character of the area, the aesthetics, traffic infrastructure and drainage infrastructure unless a comprehensive study is first conducted and a comprehensive plan for future growth and development of the area is timely implemented through the comprehensive rezoning process, in order to keep pace with the anticipated growth; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to extend said moratorium to protect and preserve the health, safety and property interests of residents from the adverse impacts of traffic, drainage and development of property that has the potential to be inconsistent with the overall development and land use of the area, and to insure consistent and compatible development of property in the future.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS that, it extends for an additional (6) months the moratorium on the submission of applications to rezone property within a portion Ward 1, District 1, which is particularly described as follows:

Any property, or part thereof, that is situated within the triangular shaped area that is bounded on the South by Highway 190, on the East by the Tchefuncte River, and on the West by the St. Tammany Parish and Tangipahoa Parish line and more specifically described as follows: From the Point of Beginning, at the intersection of the Tchefuncte River and the St. Tammany Parish and Tangipahoa Parish line, proceed in a southerly direction along the western bank of the Tchefuncte River to its intersection with Highway 190, thence proceed in a westerly direction along Highway 190 to its intersection with the St. Tammany Parish and Tangipahoa Parish line, thence proceed northerly along the St. Tammany Parish and Tangipahoa Parish line to its intersection with the Tchefuncte River, the Point of Beginning (See Attached Exhibit A).
