A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF NOT EXCEEDING \$111,000 OF CERTIFICATES OF INDEBTEDNESS, SERIES 2009, OF RECREATION DISTRICT NO. 6 OF ST. TAMMANY PARISH, LOUISIANA.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Recreation District No. 6 of St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana (the "District"), proposes to incur debt and issue One Hundred Eleven Thousand Dollars (\$111,000) of Certificates of Indebtedness, Series 2009, for the purpose of paying costs of current operations and will be secured by and payable from revenues accruing to the Issuer for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2009, and paying the costs of issuance thereof; and

WHEREAS, Sections 745 through 748, inclusive, of Title 39 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended, and other constitutional and statutory authority (the "Act"), authorize districts to pay their current expenses by anticipating their revenues for the year and to borrow money to pay these current expenses in anticipation of such revenues:

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. In compliance with the Act, and in accordance with the request of the Board of Commissioners of Recreation District No. 6 of St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana (the "District"), this Parish Council hereby approves the issuance of One Hundred Eleven Thousand Dollars (\$111,000) of Certificates of Indebtedness, Series 2009 (the "Certificates") for the purpose of paying costs of current operations (for the year 2009) and will be secured by and payable from revenues accruing to the Issuer for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2009, and paying the costs of issuance thereof. Neither St. Tammany Parish nor this Parish Council shall in any way be liable for the payment of principal and/or interest on the Certificates.
