ORDINANCE GRANTING THE PETITION FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF THE WADSWORTH COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT, STATE OF LOUISIANA. UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF CHAPTER 27-B OF TITLE 33 OF THE LOUISIANA REVISED STATUTES OF 1950, AS AMENDED (LA. R.S. 33:9039.11, ET SEQ.); AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, Chapter 27-B, Title 33 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended (La. R.S. 33:9039.11, et seq.) (the "CDD Act") allows the governing authority of parishes to create community development districts to carry out the purposes of the Act, which community development districts possess such powers and authority and have such duties as provided by the Act and other law; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Act, (a) Wadsworth Estates, L.L.C., has filed a petition for the creation of a community development district to be called the "Wadsworth Community Development District, State of Louisiana" (the "District"), which petition is attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit A; (b) the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "Parish"), acting through this Parish Council as its governing authority, has given notice of its intention to hold a public hearing, (c) an appropriate notice of public hearing was published in four (4) successive weekly issues of the Parish's official journal by the Petitioner, and (d) a public hearing on the creation of the District was held, at which public hearing no objections were received with respect to the creation of the District; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Act, this Parish Council has considered the record of the public hearing and any other relevant factors in making its determination to grant the petition for the establishment of the District and now desires to avail itself of the Act to create the District in accordance with La. R.S. 33:9039.14.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS that:

SECTION 1. Creation of District. Under the authority of La. R.S. 33:9039.14 there is hereby created a community development district within the Parish, to be named the "Wadsworth Community Development District. State of Louisiana," having the geographical boundaries set forth in Exhibit B hereto.

SECTION 2. Boundaries of District. The boundaries of the District are as set forth in Exhibit B attached hereto, which Exhibit B is hereby incorporated in and made a part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. Members of Board of Supervisors. The following persons are designated as the initial members of the board of supervisors of the District, and shall serve in that office until replaced by elected members as provided in R.S. 33:9039.15(B)(1):

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PETITION TO CREATE THE WADSWORTH COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT PURSUANT TO LA. R.S. 33:9039.14

This petition of Wadsworth Estates, LLC, which is being delivered to the St. Tammany Parish Council, the governing authority of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, pursuant to La. R.S. 33:9039.14, respectfully requests that said Parish Council proceed with the creation of a community development district pursuant to Chapter 27-B of Title 33 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended (the "CDD Act"). The undersigned petitioners are the sole owners of all of the property in the proposed district. In accordance with the CDD Act, the following information is provided:

1. <u>Boundaries of District</u>: The boundaries of the proposed district are as follows:

A CERTAIN PORTION OF GROUND, situated in the PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY, State of Louisiana, located in Section 33, Township 7 South, Range 12 East, comprised of a portion of the Northwest Quarter of Section 33, designated as WADSWORTH SUBDIVISION, and being more fully described as follows:

Begin at the Northwest corner of Section 33. Township 7 South, Range 12 East;

Thence proceed along the northerly line of the aforesaid Section 33, South 89 degrees, 31 minutes, 47 seconds East, a distance of 996.86 feet to a point; thence proceed along the southerly line of a 30' United Gas Pipeline right-of-way, South 59 degrees, 04 minutes, 50 seconds East, a distance of 1,286.84 feet to a point:

Thence proceed South 01 degrees, 55 minutes, 27 seconds West, a distance of 627.38 feet to a point of curve;

Thence proceed along a curve to the left, in a southeasterly direction, with a radius of 12 feet, having an arc length of 14.71 feet, along a chord bearing of South 33 degrees. 11 minutes, 50 seconds East, a distance of 13.81 feet to a point of continuous curve:

Thence proceed along a curve to the left, in a southeasterly direction, with a radius of 135.61 feet, having an arc length of 50.21 feet, along a chord bearing of South 78 degrees, 55 minutes, 27 seconds East, a distance of 49.92 feet to a point of tangent;

Thence proceed South 89 degrees, 31 minutes, 47 seconds East, a distance of 185.33 feet to a point located on the westerly right-of-way line of Wadsworth Parkway (a 100' ROW);

Thence proceed along the aforesaid right-of-way line. South 01 degrees, 55 minutes, 27 seconds. West, a distance of 280.09 feet to a point:

Thence proceed North 89 degrees, 31 minutes, 47 seconds West, a distance of 178.22 feet to a point of curve;

Thence proceed along a curve to the right, in a northwesterly direction, with a radius of 415.61 feet, having an arc length of 209.40 feet, along a chord bearing of North 75 degrees, 05 minutes, 46 seconds West, a distance of 207.19 feet to a point;

Thence proceed South 63 degrees, 55 minutes, 43 seconds West, a distance of 70.82 feet to a point;

Thence proceed North 89 degrees, 31 minutes, 47 seconds West, a distance of 32.41 feet to a point;

Thence proceed South 01 degrees, 55 minutes, 27 seconds West, a distance of 157.30 feet to a point of curve;

Thence proceed along a curve to the right, in a southwesterly direction, with a radius of 100 feet, having an arc length of 77.96 feet, along a chord bearing of South 24 degrees, 15 minutes, 30 seconds West, a distance of 76 feet to a point of reverse curve;

Thence proceed along a curve to the left, in a southwesterly direction, with a radius of 490 feet, having an arc length of 110.57 feet, along a chord bearing of South 40 degrees, 07 minutes, 41 seconds West, a distance of 110.34 feet to a point of tangent;

Thence proceed South 33 degrees, 39 minutes, 49 seconds West, a distance of 239.42 feet to a point of curve;

Thence proceed along a curve to the right, in a southwesterly direction, with a radius of 180 feet, having an arc length of 149.11 feet, along a chord bearing of South 57 degrees, 23 minutes, 37 seconds West, a distance of 144.88 feet to a point of tangent;

Thence proceed South 81 degrees, 07 minutes, 26 seconds West, a distance of 373.17 feet to a point of curve;


Thence proceed along a curve to the right, in a northwesterly direction, with a radius of 440 feet, having an arc length of 206.82 feet, along a chord bearing of North 85 degrees, 24 minutes, 38 seconds West, a distance of 204.92 feet to a point of reverse curve;

Thence proceed along a curve to the left, in a southwesterly direction, with a radius of 340 feet, having an arc length of 280.61 feet, along a chord bearing of South 84 degrees. 24 minutes, 40 seconds West, a distance of 272.71 feet to a point of reverse curve;

Thence proceed along a curve to the right, in a northwesterly direction, with a radius of 260 feet, having an arc length of 410.10 feet, along a chord bearing of North 74 degrees, 02 minutes, 45 seconds West, a distance of 368.89 feet to a non-tangent point;

Thence proceed North 68 degrees, 32 minutes, 54 seconds West, a distance of 292.49 feet to a point on the common section line of Sections 32 and 33, Township 7 South, Range 12 Fast: Thence proceed along the aforesaid section line, North 00 degrees, 06 minutes, 55 seconds West, a distance of 2,022.74 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

The above described portion of ground contains 92.5034 acres more or less.


