AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE III, SECTION 3-02 OF THE HOME RULE CHARTER OF THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY, STATE OF LOUISIANA.

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 3-02 of the Home Rule Charter currently provides as follows:

"Section 3-02. Election.

The president shall be elected at large by the qualified voters of the Parish according to the election laws of the state for a four (4) year term. A person who has served as president for more than two and one-half terms in three (3) consecutive terms shall not be eligible to qualify as a candidate for president for the succeeding term."

WHEREAS, this Parish Council proposes to call an election to be held on May 2, 2009, for the submission of the following proposition relative to the amendment of said Article III, Section 3-02 of the Home Rule Charter of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana:

CHARTER AMENDMENT PROPOSITION

Summary: Amendment to Article III, Section 3-02 to permit the current Parish President, Kevin Davis, to qualify as a candidate for the office of Parish President for the next term.

Shall Article III, Section 3-02 of the Home Rule Charter be amended to hereafter provide as follows:

"Section 3-02, Election.

The president shall be elected at large by the qualified voters of the Parish according to the election laws of the state for a four (4) year term. A person who has served as president for more than two and one-half terms in three (3) consecutive terms shall not be eligible to qualify as a candidate for president for the succeeding term. However, the current president, Kevin Davis, shall be eligible to qualify as a candidate for president for the 2012-2015 term."

WHEREAS, subject to the approval of the voters at the May 2, 2009 election, this Parish Council now desires to provide for an amendment to said Home Rule Charter.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS by the Parish Council of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana (the "Parish"), that:

SECTION 1. <u>Amendment</u>. Subject to voter approval at an election to be held on May 2, 2009, Article III, Section 3-02 of the Home Rule Charter of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, is hereby amended to provide as follows:

"Section 3-02. Election.

The president shall be elected at large by the qualified voters of the Parish according to the election laws of the state for a four (4) year term. A person who has served as president for more than two and one-half terms in three (3) consecutive terms shall not be eligible to qualify as a candidate for president for the succeeding term. However, the current president, Kevin Davis, shall be eligible to qualify as a candidate for president for the 2012-2015 term."

SECTION 2. <u>Repeal</u>. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any or more of the provisions of this ordinance shall for any reason be held to be illegal or invalid, such illegality or invalidity shall not affect any other provision of this ordinance, but this ordinance shall be construed and enforced as if such illegal or invalid provisions had not been contained herein. Any constitutional or statutory provision enacted after the date of this ordinance which validates or makes legal any provision of this ordinance which would not otherwise be valid or legal, shall be deemed to apply to this ordinance.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption, being an ordinance affecting the public peace, health and safety.
