ADOPTED MAY 16, 1996; TO PROVIDE FOR THE RE-OPENING OF CLEO
ROAD.

WHEREAS, Resolution P.J.S. No. 96-7604, adopted May 16, 1996 authorized the temporary closure of Cleo Road (R08H012) to alleviate promiscuous dumping activity, subsequent fines, and in accordance with DEQ compliance order for site ID No. D-103-8135; and

WHEREAS, the dumping problem has been corrected and it is no longer necessary to keep said Cleo Road closed.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY RESOLVES to rescind Resolution Police Jury Series No. 96-7604, adopted May 16, 1996; to provide for the re-opening of Cleo Road.

RESOLUTION POLICE JURY SERIES NO. 96-7604

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CLEO ROAD (8-H-012); TO ALLEVIATE PROMISCUOUS DUMPING ACTIVITY AND SUBSEQUENT FINES FOR SAME, IN ACCORDANCE WITH DEQ COMPLIANCE ORDER FOR SITE ID NO. D-103-8135.

1 WHEREAS, Cleo Road (8-H-012) has experienced promiscuous dumping activity for
2 several years; and

4 WHEREAS, the St. Tammany Parish Police Jury has continually had to clean up this area
5 to allow for the safe passage of motorists along the roadway and to prevent enforcement action from
6 the Department of Environmental Quality regarding the unsanitary condition of the property; and

8 WHEREAS, on 1/23/96 DEQ conducted an investigation regarding the promiscuous
9 dumping and recommended that a Compliance Order for Site ID No. D-103-8135 be issued to the
10 St. Tammany Parish Police Jury ordering that Cleo Road be cleaned immediately; and

12 WHEREAS, possible civil penalties of not more than \$25,000.00 for each day of violation
13 may be assessed; and

15 WHEREAS, in accordance with same the St. Tammany Parish Police Jury contracted for
16 said clean-up and acquired permission to place gates at two (2) locations on Cleo Road provided that
17 same provided access to all affected parties and/or property owners from either Highway 11 or
18 Military Road;

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ST. TAMMANY PARISH POLICE
21 JURY that it herewith authorizes the temporary closure of Cleo Road (8-H-012); to alleviate
22 promiscuous dumping activity and subsequent fines for same, in accordance with DEQ Compliance
23 Order for Site ID No. D-103-8135;

25 FURTHER, said closure shall be accomplished by the placement of two (2) gates on Cleo
26 Road and all affected parties shall be provided access from one of two entrance points, either
27 Highway 11 or Military Road.
