Honorable Council Members:

The Warranty Obligation in the amount of \$81,000 expires April 15, 2009 and is scheduled for review by the Parish Council at the March 5, 2009 meeting.

The developer was notified on January 7, 2009 by the Department of Engineering of the punch list items required and for his engineer to certify to this office at least sixty (60) days prior to the expiration of the obligation, that the punch list has been completed.

This office has not received such notification. Therefore, this obligation must be extended for one (1) year or until the work is satisfactorily accomplished.

The following punch list items remain:

- Traffic and street name signs need to be installed in accordance with "TRAFFIC SIGNAGE PLAN" dated September 2007 sheet 13 of 24 by KLL Consultants:
 - a. Roadways that will eventually be maintained by STP must have street name signs with Blue background with YELLOW lettering. (Contact STP Public Works Department for proper color shades);
 - b. South Lake Drive, since it is a private road, must have street name signs with GREEN background with WHITE lettering;
 - c. Do not install "SIGNAL AHEAD SIGNS" at this time, since the signals are not installed:
 - d. Do not install the Stop sign in the median of West End Blvd. at the intersection of Oak Harbor Blvd.;

e. Need BARRICADE signage at all temporary dead ends;

f. A signage plan needs to be furnished for our review of that portion of West End Blvd. previously constructed, since the Parish will be taking that portion of roadway into the Selective Parish maintenance system also. Upon approval of the signage plan those signs must be installed.

The following work has been satisfactorily completed:

- Roadside ditches have been regraded;
- 2. Permanent signage has been installed;
- 3. Blue reflectors have been replaced;
- 4. Recreation amenities are complete;
- 5. Asphalt roadway surface is satisfactory.

Temporary gravel cul de sacs at the end of Foliage Court and Autumn Green Drive remain. The roads have not been extended and it will be necessary that a \$10,000 Performance Obligation be established for a period of six (6) months to cover the cost of hard surfacing the two (2) cul de sacs until such time that the roadways are extended.

Therefore, it is recommended that the Warranty Obligation in the amount of \$37,700 be released and a \$10,000 Performance Obligation be established.

This is a public access subdivision and the Parish will maintain roadways and roadside ditches. The Homeowners Association is responsible for maintenance of detention ponds.
