ORDINANCE TO EXTEND FOR AN ADDITIONAL SIX (6) MONTHS THE MORATORIUM ON THE RECEIPT OF APPLICATIONS BY THE PARISH ZONING COMMISSION FOR MOBILE HOME CONDITIONAL USE PERMITS AND/OR ON THE ISSUANCE OF BUILDING PERMITS FOR PLACEMENT OF MOBILE HOMES ON PROPERTY WITHIN BAYOU HEIGHTS SUBDIVISION. (WARD 6, DISTRICT 6)

WHEREAS, property within Bayou Heights Subdivision has mixed zoning which allows mobile homes as permitted uses in some portions of the subdivision and mobile homes as conditional uses in other areas of the subdivision; and

WHEREAS, given the manner in which this subdivision has developed, the Parish Council adopted Ordinance C.S. No. 08-1937 extending the six (6) month moratorium on the placement of mobile homes within the subdivision; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to further extend the moratorium in order to evaluate the compatibility and potential impacts of additional mobile homes in Bayou Heights Subdivision and to determine corrective measures to protect and preserve the health, safety and property interests of residents residing therein.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS that it extends for an additional six (6) months the moratorium on the receipt of applications by the Parish Zoning Commission for mobile home conditional use permits and/or on the issuance of building permits for placement of mobile homes on property within Bayou Heights Subdivision. (Ward 6, District 6)

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon final adoption and shall remain in effect through October 2, 2009.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the moratorium imposed may be vacated, in whole or in part, by Resolution of this governing body pursuant to Chapter 5, Article II, Section 5-056.00 of the Parish Code of Ordinances.

REPEAL: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.
