ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A "NO PARKING" ZONE ON PAWNS LANE (8-I-66) (WARD 8, DISTRICT 9)

WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish Government is charged with protecting the safety and general welfare of citizens of the parish; and

WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish has experienced an increase in parking along portions of Pawns Lane; and

WHEREAS, affected citizens have requested control measures be taken to address this unsafe situation on Parish roads.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS, that

SECTION I: A "NO PARKING" zone is hereby established on the westerly side of Pawns Lane beginning at Brownsitch Road and continuing to S. Queens Drive and on both sides of Pawns Lane beginning at S. Queens Drive and continuing to Chess Drive.

SECTION II: The Parish Department of Public Works is directed to post the appropriate signs at these locations, in accordance with the attached Engineering data.

REPEAL: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any other provision herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

DATE OF ENACTMENT: This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption.
