RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT ST. TAMMANY PARISH GOVERNMENT'S APPLICATIONS FOR FUNDING FROM THE LOUISIANA COMMUNITY WATER ENRICHMENT FUND TO IMPROVE TWO (2) WATER SYSTEMS.

WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish Government ("Parish") has been afforded the opportunity to apply for \$ 97,000 of funding from the Community Water Enrichment Fund, which is administered by the Louisiana Office of Community Development; and

WHEREAS, the Parish has two (2) projects that require equipment to ensure the delivery of potable water by the Parish to its customers on a daily basis, as well as in emergency situations; and

WHEREAS, the Parish would like to install a control panel and two (2) split case pumps with electric skid mounted motors as well as clean and inspect the water tower at the Briarwood water system which serves 3,640 customers in Mandeville; and

WHEREAS, the Parish would like to install two (2) emergency pumps at the Fabourg water system which serves 1,700 customers in Madisonville.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY RESOLVES to support the Parish's grant applications for funding from the Community Water Enrichment Fund.
