Resolution approving the holding of an election in St. Tammany Parish Recreation District No. 11, State of Louisiana, on Saturday, March 24, 2012, to authorize the renewal of a special tax therein.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of St. Tammany Parish Recreation District No. 11, State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of St. Tammany Parish Recreation District No. 11, State of Louisiana (the "District"), adopted a resolution on November 14, 2011, calling a special election in the District on Saturday, March 24, 2012, to authorize the renewal of a special tax therein; and

WHEREAS, the governing authority of the District has requested that this Parish Council, acting as the governing authority of the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, give its consent and authority for the District to hold the aforesaid election, and in the event that the election carries to levy and collect the special tax provided for therein; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article VI, Section 15 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, it is now the desire of this Parish Council to approve the holding of said election and, in the event that the election carries, to further approve the levy and collection of the special tax provided for therein.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. In accordance with the provisions of Article VI, Section 15 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, and in accordance with the request of the Board of Commissioners of St. Tammany Parish Recreation District No. 4, State of Louisiana, this Parish Council hereby approves the holding of an election in the District, on Saturday, March 24, 2012, at which election there will be submitted the following proposition, to-wit:

PROPOSITION (MILLAGE RENEWAL)

Summary: 10 year, 10 mills property tax renewal for acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining or operating parks, playgrounds, recreation centers and other recreational facilities in the District.

Shall St. Tammany Parish Recreation District No. 11, State of Louisiana (the "District"), continue to levy a special tax of ten (10) mills on all property subject to taxation in the District (an estimated \$368,000 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the tax for an entire year), for a period of ten (10) years, beginning with the year 2013 and ending with the year 2022, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining or operating parks, playgrounds, recreation centers and other recreational facilities in said District, together with the necessary furnishings and equipment therefor?

SECTION 2. In the event the election carries, this Parish Council does hereby further consent to and authorize the District to levy and collect the special tax provided for therein.
