WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish owns right-of-way named Oak Harbor Boulevard, consisting of lanes for vehicle traffic, a median and other appurtenances; and

WHEREAS, Oak Harbor Property Owners Association desires to place subdivision-identifying signage in the median of Oak Harbor Boulevard near the intersection with Highway 11 as depicted on the plans attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, there is a necessity for the placement of identifying signing inside the median of Oak Harbor Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to St. Tammany Parish Code of Ordinances, Section 35-32(g), Parish Council may grant a special permit for placement of signage in Parish's right-of-way.

RESOLUTION TO GRANT A SPECIAL PERMIT FOR THE PLACEMENT OF SIGNAGE ON PARISH RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR OAK HARBOR PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION (WARD 9, DISTRICT 12)

Oak Harbor HOA has inquired for permission to place signage in an existing traffic median situated within the right-of-way comprising Oak Harbor Boulevard. With some exceptions, signage in the Parish right-of-way is not allowed. However, the Council, by Ordinance or Resolution, may grant temporary or permanent special permits authorizing signage in the right of way.

In this instance, signage will be placed within an already-constructed traffic median, and replaces prior signage that was removed as part LaDOTD improvements to Highway 11.
