ORDINANCE TO EXTEND FOR SIX (6) MONTHS THE MORATORIUM ON THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS FOR CONSTRUCTION OR PLACEMENT OF ANY BUILDING STRUCTURES ON PROPERTY WITHIN A DEFINED AREA NORTH OF NORTH STREET, SOUTH OF HARRISON AVENUE, WEST OF RAVINE STREET, AND EAST OF EIKE STREET AND FUSCHIA STREET WITHIN UNINCORPORATED BOUNDARIES OF WARD 3, DISTRICT 5.

WHEREAS, on February 4, 2016, the Parish Council adopted Ordinance C.S. No. 16-3459 imposing a six-month moratorium on the issuance of permits for construction or placement of any building structures within a certain portion of unincorporated Ward 3, District 5 of St Tammany Parish; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to further extend the moratorium to protect and preserve the health, safety and property interests of residents from the adverse effects of flooding hazards resulting from severe drainage problems and flooding within a certain portion of unincorporated Ward 3, District 5 of St Tammany Parish.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS: that it extends for an additional six (6) months the moratorium on the issuance of permits for construction or placement of any building structures on property within the defined area north of North Street, south of Harrison Avenue, west of Ravine Street, and east of Eike Street and Fuschia Street within unincorporated boundaries of Ward 3, District 5 of St. Tammany Parish, all as indicated on the map attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall be effective immediately upon final adoption and shall remain in effect through August 2, 2019.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the extended moratorium may be vacated, in whole or in part, by Resolution of this governing body pursuant to Chapter 2, Article XVI, Section 2-264 of the Parish Code of Ordinances.

REPEAL: All ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
