RESOLUTION OBLIGATING FUNDS TO LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND PROJECT FOR THE LACOMBE TRACE TRAILS AND NATURE PARK.

WHEREAS, the St. Tammany Parish Council is interested in acquiring lands and/or developing outdoor recreational facilities on the following described project for the enjoyment of the citizenry of the

Parish of St. Tammany and the State of Louisiana:

PROJECT TITLE AND DESCRIPTION:

THE LACOMBE TRACE TRAILS AND NATURE PARK

WHEREAS, in November, 2011, St. Tammany Parish entered into an agreement with the Department of the Interior, Bureau of Ocean Energy Management, Regulation, and Enforcement, for the purpose of acquiring a 26.311-acre parcel of property in St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish is developing a master plan for this exciting new recreational resource and destination for its residents on this parcel of land, which property is connected to the Tammany Trace along the banks of the scenic Bayou Lacombe in Lacombe, Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, the site offers a plethora of opportunities for residents and guests to engage with the natural environment and historic past. The plans call for upgrades to boating and fishing access including a fishing dock, kayak launch and new and expanded parking area. Restrooms, pavilions, trails, boardwalks and picnic areas will offer further amenities for all ages; and

WHEREAS, the trails will include interpretive stations to highlight the bottom land swamp flora and fauna as well as the history of the site including uses ranging from the Choctaw Indians to the Tammany Railway to more recent barge building operations and the importance of conservation, coastal restoration and hurricane protection as well as infrastructure that is directly affected by coastal wetland losses; and

WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish's increased vulnerability to hurricane events/storm surge is a result of many things – one being land loss, whose contributing factors include oil and gas exploration activities. St. Tammany Parish is eager to polish this gem along the already successful Tammany Trace to broaden the access to its waterways and provide a phenomenal new park for our residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, this recreational facility will be located in St. Tammany Parish Recreation District No. 4 and will benefit the residents of Lacombe and St. Tammany Parish as well as visitors to St. Tammany Parish; and

WHEREAS, any wiring covered in this project, or wiring done in the future on this site, will be placed underground in order to maintain a safe environment for St. Tammany Parish residents and visitors.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the St. Tammany Parish Council, State of Louisiana, that said St. Tammany Parish Council does agree to obligate the funds or services stipulated below to satisfactorily complete the following project and thus become eligible for Land and Water Conservation Fund financial aid of 50% of the estimated or actual allowable cost, at the completion of said project. Said St. Tammany Parish Council also states that sufficient funds are on hand, as of this date, to fund said project as follows:
