Total project funding is \$611,620.00 as follows: \$107,022.47 from Capital Projects fund 201-4606 - Drainage - Parishwide, \$32,480.00 from Special Revenue fund 100-4601 - Public Works, \$111,015.47 from VDA funds, \$341,102.06 from FEMA, and \$20,000.00 from Capital Projects fund 200-4653 - Sales Tax District 3 - District 13.
