AMENDMENT NO. 37 - 2021 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS - JUNE 2021**

**MULTIPLE FUNDS**

**Funding Source: LA Safe and CDBG Entitlement Grant Funds**

**SECTION I: CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS - INFRASTRUCTURE (ROADS, BRIDGES, DRAINAGE, AND UTILITIES)**

Safe Haven Pkwy. Intersections	Allocate available LA Safe grant funds to replace the pavement at the intersections along Safe Haven Pkwy. with permeable concrete, colored and stamped into a pattern that designates the nodes for pedestrian crossing as well as aesthetic and ecological treatments.
Safe Haven Roadway Sidewalks	Allocate available LA Safe grant funds to construct paved sidewalks along roadways not yet identified to accommodate pedestrian passage.
Safe Haven Stormwater Management	Allocate available LA Safe grant funds to create an ecologically sensitive hydrologic system to better address stormwater at the Safe Haven Campus including, but not limited to, ponds, ditch maintenance, stormwater park, and bioslows.
Safe Haven Utilities	Allocate available CDBG Entitlement grant funds to upgrade the campus' water and sewer systems. Improvements will include sewer manhole rehabilitation, fence replacement, lift station servicing, water well electrical panel replacement, and shed replacement.
Safe Haven Nature Trails	Allocate available LA Safe grant funds to create pedestrian pathways that meander through preserved areas.

**SECTION II: CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS - FACILITIES**

Safe Haven Campus Master Plan	Allocate available LA Safe grant funds to provide for Grant Administration of the conceptual master plan.
Safe Haven Entrance Landscaping	Allocate available LA Safe grant funds to add a sign and landscaping to make a visible entrance to the campus.
Safe Haven Informational Signage	Allocate available LA Safe grant funds to establish a consistent sign package for information and directions throughout the campus. The package will include kiosks, facility identification signs, direction signs, and street crossing signs.
Safe Haven Pavilions	Allocate available LA Safe grant funds to add several sites for open air pavilions ranging from 450 to 850 feet throughout the campus.
