THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS: that

SECTION I: A "No Parking" zone is hereby established on White Heron Dr., see attached map (R01M025)

SECTION II: The Parish Department of Public Works is directed to post the appropriate signage at this location.

REPEAL: All ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after adoption.
