WHEREAS, Oak Harbor subdivision is a private community and its owners association has requested the Parish to authorize the enforcement of state and local traffic laws by the St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office upon the private streets of the subdivision.		
WHEREAS, due to safety concerns, the Oak Harbor owners association has requested that the maximum speed limit established by ordinance be reduced to 20 miles per hour.		
Ordinances, Part I, Chapter 24-Motor Vehicles and	Y ORDAINS: that St. Tammany Parish Code of Traffic, Article III-Operation on Private Roads and Sec. 24-206-Speed Limits/Traffic Controls shall be	
Sec. 24-206 Speed limits/traffic controls.		
It shall be unlawful for any person to operate or drive a motor vehicle upon the private streets within Oak Harbor Subdivision at a rate of speed in excess of $\frac{25}{20}$ miles per hour.

SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.
