RESOLUTION TO CLARIFY RESPONSIBILITY FOR MAINTENANCE OF CERTAIN DRAINAGE FEATURES AND INFRASTRUCTURE ABUTTING HUNTERS GLEN SUBDIVISION

WHEREAS, Hunters Glen Property Owners Association has requested that the responsibility for maintenance of certain drainage features and obligations related to infrastructure abutting Hunters Glen subdivision;

WHEREAS, the Parish acknowledges its ownership and maintenance obligations of the retention pond behind Hunters Glen subdivision within the Tammany Trace right-of-way;

WHEREAS, the Parish acknowledges and reaffirms the addition of Hunters Glen Lateral Ditch #D04DW01999 to the St. Tammany Parish Selective Road and Drainage Maintenance System as reflected in Ordinance Council Series No. 08-1772;

WHEREAS, the Parish acknowledges the permission granted to Hunters Glen Property Owners Association to construct a pedestrian link from the subdivision to the Tammany Trace as established in Resolution Police Jury Series No. 99-9311, and further acknowledged that all maintenance, expense, and liability related to infrastructure placed by the subdivision in the Tammany Trace right-of-way shall be maintained in perpetuity by the Hunters Glen Property Owners Association and may be removed by the Parish at any time as deemed necessary by St. Tammany Parish Government.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY RESOLVES that St. Tammany Parish Government shall continue to maintain the retention pond within the Tammany Trace right-of-way abutting the rear of Hunters Glen subdivision;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the maintenance of Hunters Glen Lateral Ditch #D04DW01999 shall be continued by St. Tammany Parish Government;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that St. Tammany Parish Government acknowledges that Hunters Glen Property Owners Association was granted permission through Resolution Police Jury Series No. 99-9311 to construct a pedestrian link between their subdivision and Tammany Trace; and as stated in that resolution, any infrastructure built in connection therewith shall be maintained at the sole expense and responsibility by the Hunters Glen Property Owners Association, and may be removed by the Parish at any time as deemed necessary by St. Tammany Parish Government.
