ORDINANCE TO AMEND ST. TAMMANY PARISH CODE OF ORDINANCES, PART I, CHAPTER 24-MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE III-OPERATION ON PRIVATE ROADS AND SUBDIVISIONS, DIVISION 6-OAK HARBOR SUBDIVISION, SEC. 24-206-SPEED LIMITS/TRAFFIC CONTROLS.

WHEREAS, Oak Harbor subdivision is a private community and its owners association has requested the Parish to authorize the enforcement of state and local traffic laws by the St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office upon the private streets of the subdivision.

WHEREAS, due to safety concerns, the Oak Harbor owners association has requested that the maximum speed limit established by ordinance be reduced to 20 miles per hour.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS: that St. Tammany Parish Code of Ordinances, Part I, Chapter 24-Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Article III-Operation on Private Roads and Subdivisions, Division 6-Oak Harbor Subdivision, Sec. 24-206-Speed Limits/Traffic Controls shall be amended as follows:

Sec. 24-206. - Speed limits/traffic controls.

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate or drive a motor vehicle upon the private streets within Oak Harbor Subdivision at a rate of speed in excess of 25 20 miles per hour.

REPEAL: All ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after adoption.
