ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A NO PARKING ZONE IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 13 AND COUNCIL DISTRICT 14.

WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish Government is charged with protecting the safety and welfare of the citizens of St. Tammany Parish.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS: A "NO PARKING" zone is hereby established in Council District 13 and Council District 14:

Parking of trucks, trailers, etc., in residential, semi-residential, semi-commercial zones.

A. In Council District 13 and Council District 14, it shall be unlawful for any person to park, or cause to be parked, any semi-tractor, bus, truck, semi-trailer or boat trailer, except a pickup truck of three quarter ton capacity or less and standard design, upon any street, alley or right of way, except for expeditious delivery or pick up of materials.

1. The provisions of this section shall not apply to:

- a. Vehicles temporarily parked while loading or unloading such vehicle,
- b. Emergency vehicles while said vehicle and its operator are on call for emergency services, and
- c. Government vehicles and authorized contractors

d. For the purposes of this section, "Vehicle" means any semi-trailer or boat trailer, except a pickup truck of three-quarter ton capacity or less and standard design. "Semi-tractor" means a motor vehicle designed and used primarily for drawing, towing, or pulling a semi-trailer. "Semi-trailer" means a vehicle without motive power and so designed in conjunction and used with a motor vehicle that some part of its own weight and that of its own load rests or is carried by another vehicle, and having one or more load-carrying axles.

e. Penalties: Violators of the provisions of this section shall be assessed a civil fine to be paid to the parish as follows:

- 1. First offense: \$ 300.00;
- 2. Second offense (and any subsequent offense which occurs within three years of the first offense): \$ 450.00; and
- 3. Each calendar day during which a violation of the section occurs shall constitute a separate offense.

REPEAL: All ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after adoption.
