Ordinance Administrative Comment

ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE PARISH CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 3 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, ARTICLE VI WARDS 2 AND 6, SECTION 3-124 QUALIFICATIONS OF APPLICANTS FOR PERMITS GENERALLY AND CHAPTER 3 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, ARTICLE VII OTHER WARDS, SECTION 3-161 QUALIFICATIONS OF APPLICANTS FOR PERMITS GENERALLY TO AMEND RESIDENCY RESTRICTIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH LOUISIANA REVISED STATUTE TITLE 26, SECTION 80.

This revision is necessary to bring the Parish's alcohol permit qualifications in line with Louisiana law. Per varied Attorney General provisions, the Parish's existing ordinance exceeds the authority granted by the Louisiana Revised Statutes.
